

**THE RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY
CITY OF CHETOPA, KANSAS**

July 12, 2022

The Chetopa City Council met in special session on Tuesday, July 12, 2022 at 7:00 p.m., at City Hall, for the specific purpose of discussion of non-elected personnel.

PRESIDING: Mayor Tammy Bushong

PRESENT: Council Members/Bob Boyd, Linda Seaman, Juanita Kepner, Geraldine Castle and Ernie Wulf. Pam Campbell was not present.

ALSO PRESENT: Clerk/Toni A. Crumrine and Interim City Supervisor/Police Chief Scott Feagan.

Mayor Bushong called the meeting to order and led the council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance and opened the meeting with prayer.

Motion by Wulf, second by Kepner to enter into executive session to discuss non-elected personnel with mayor, council, clerk and interim city supervisor/police chief present for twenty (20) minutes with session to end at 7:24 p.m. Motion carried.

Mayor Bushong called the meeting back to order and the following action was taken.

Motion by Kepner, second by Wulf to enter back into executive session to continue discussion of non-elected personnel with mayor, council, clerk and interim city supervisor/police chief present to an additional twenty (20) minutes with session ending at 7:45 p.m. Motion carried.

Mayor Bushong called the meeting back to order and the following action was taken.

Motion by Wulf, second by Castle to call the stronger four (4) applicants in for a second interview with the mayor, two (2) council members and Feagan. Motion carried.

The two council members that volunteered were Castle and Seaman, but Seaman stated she may not be able to come and asked to have Kepner take her place in the interview and there was no opposition to this. Clerk Crumrine will set up interviews with the four applicants for Wednesday evening starting at 6:00 p.m.

Motion by Seaman, second by Wulf to adjourn. Motion carried.
