

ORDINANCE NO. 1014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-221 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY CHETOPA, KANSAS, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 999, RELATING TO WATER RATES WITHIN SAID CITY AND OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHETOPA, KANSAS:

SECTION I. That section 15-221 of the City Code of the City of Chetopa, Kansas, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-221. Residence and Industrial Water Rates. Rates for water by the City of Chetopa, Kansas, to residential, commercial and industrial users for properties located within said City of Chetopa, shall be as follows:

For the first one thousand (1,000) gallons, or fractional part thereof, consumed per a minimum charge of forty-two dollars and forty-three cents (\$42.43).

For all in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons consumed per month a charge of twelve dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$13.00) per thousand (1,000) gallons.

15-221. Water Rates for Users Outside the City Boundaries. Rates for water furnished by the City of Chetopa, Kansas to residential, commercial and industrial users who are non-residential of the said City of Chetopa, Kansas, shall be as follows:

For the first one thousand (1,000) gallons, or fractional part thereof, consumed per.

A minimum charge of sixty-three dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$63.67).

For all in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons, or fractional part thereof, consumed per month a charge of eighteen dollars and fifty-four cents (\$19.47) per thousand (1,000) gallons.

SECTION 2. That these rates will be automatically increased by 5% each year on the anniversary of the date of the passage of this Ordinance until further action to and if the governing body changes the percentage of the increase or eliminates the increase all together.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect on the 4th day of August, 2026.
